The summarized report of the observations and the suggestions during the academic audit of the departments by the experts is given below:

Teaching-Learning and Evaluation

- Establishment of Smart classrooms with ICT enabled resources were suggested by external experts.
- 2. The ratio of Mentor-Mentees was observed to be satisfactory.
- 3. Recruitment of professors was suggested by experts.
- 4. More Expert lectures/workshops/seminars from renowned academicians were proposed.
- 5. Adjunct faculty and visiting professors should be engaged in the departments.

Curricular Aspects

- 1. Offering of cross-cutting courses related to gender equity and human values was suggested.
- 2. In most of the programmes, Choice Based Credit System is implemented and syllabus is suggested to be revised according to NEP.
- 3. In the various departments, inter-disciplinary courses, value added courses were suggested to be included in the curriculum.
- 4. Parents and alumni feedback should be taken while curriculum designing.

Research, Innovation and Extension

- 1. Research orientation activities should be encouraged.
- 2. There should be more focus on increasing the activities under existing MoUs and Collaborations.

- 3. To give more industry exposure to the pupils, it is suggested that more emphasis should be laid on industrial visits and other industry-academia activities.
- 4. The existing consultancy work is satisfactory and expert suggested engagement of more departments in the consultancy activities.
- 5. Interdisciplinary research among various departments should be encouraged in the university.
- 6. Seed money should be provided to the faculty members to promote research.
- 7. A central instrumentation facility should be established.
- 8. Awareness activities should be conducted in the adopted villages of university.

Student Support and Progression

- 1. Department should take initiative to encourage and guide students for higher studies.
- 2. More placements drives should be conducted for the students.
- 3. Participation of students at the international level activities should be encouraged.
- 4. The number of activities should be increased which will enhance the communication skills of the students.
- 5. The expert suggested that students with excellent performance in academic as well as extracurricular activities should be honored.
- 6. Alumni should be encouraged to contribute towards the university.
